MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Tennessee Army National Guard (TNARNG) Personnel Policy for Retired Regular Army Warrant Officer Accessions into the TNARNG

1. References:

2. Purpose. This policy provides implementation guidance to appoint Retired Regular Army (RA) Warrant Officers (WO) as Tennessee Army National Guard (TNARNG) WOs with retention on the U.S. Army Retired List.

3. Applicability. This policy applies to Retired RA WOs who are on the Regular Army (RA) Retired List. It does not apply to Retired Reserve Component (RC) Commissioned Officers or Retired Active Guard and Reserve (AGR) Commissioned Officers and WOs. Appointment may only occur following the established guidance and policies in references 1a, 1b, and 1c.

a. The TNARNG Command Chief Warrant Officer (CCWO) will identify critical vacancies and/or gaps in the TNARNG WO Cohort and publish those MOS's for all Military Personnel Management Offices of all US Army Active-Duty Commands in coordination with Deputy Chief of Staff G1 (DSC/G1) - Human Resources Command (HRC). The list of MOS's that the TNARNG will accept RA WOs into will be published in MILPER message updates and periodically on S1net at the discretion of the State Command Chief Warrant Officer (CCWO).

b. Retired RA WOs may only apply for published vacancies by contacting the TNARNG Warrant Officer Strength Manager (WOSM). Once the WOSM has a complete and approved packet, the WOSM will coordinate with TNARNG Officer

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
Personnel Branch for the Retired RA WO to be accessed into the TNARNG. Final approval for accessions into TNARNG is The Adjutant General (TAG) under advisement of National Guard Bureau (NGB) and the State CCWO.

c. Retired RA WOs will only be accepted into TNARNG for an initial three-year tour. Continuation after the initial tour will be granted on a case-by-case basis, with The TAG serving as the approval authority for continuation. Continuation after the reappointed WO's initial tour will be based on the needs of the TNARNG and performance of the reappointed WO. Preferred ranks for accession are W2 and W3. Retired WOs in the rank of W4 will be accessed by exception and at the discretion of the State CCWO. No W5's will be accepted.
